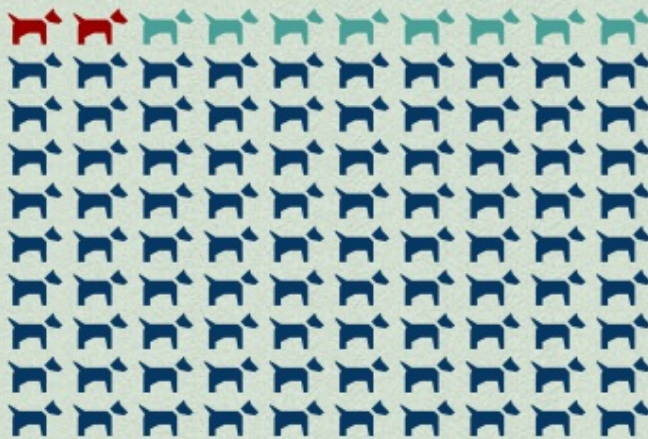
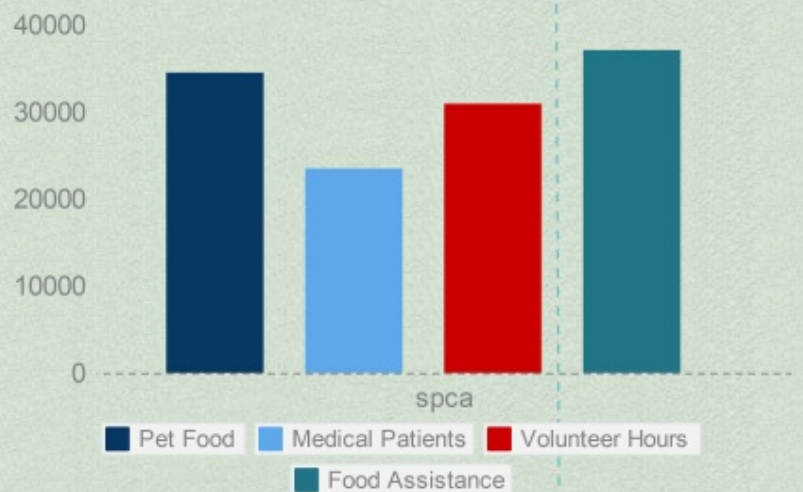

Last year, our caring staff matched 5,011 pets with their forever homes, an increase of 974 from 2013. SPCA Florida invests \$265 in every dog and cat cared for by our agency. All adopted animals are examined by a veterinarian, spayed or neutered, vaccinated, permanently identified with a microchip and go home with heart-worm prevention.
